2010 Student Jewelry Design Competition

The Competition:

The Midwest Jeweler's Trade Show invites students from Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, North Dakota, South Dakota, Michigan, and Indiana to participate in a post secondary jewelry design competition.

Eligibility:

Any full-time student enrolled in a jewelry or related program at a secondary institution from Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, North Dakota, South Dakota, Michigan, or Indiana. Persons in training as an apprentice in a jewelry store are also eligible to participate.

Rules of Entry:

Items must be under the supervision of an instructor.

Metals can be gold, silver, or any alloy the student chooses.

Synthetic stones can be used.

Entry limit is one piece per category and you may enter one or all categories.

Pieces must be original designs, created and crafted by the person entering them.

All entries must be designed and produced within 12 months of the contest and crafted by the person entering them and cannot have been mass-produced or previously sold.

Pieces may have entered other competitions, but can not have won any awards.

Judging:

The entries will be judged by qualified people in the fashion and jewelry industry. The criteria for judging of the design pieces will be based on: Quality, craftsmanship, degree of difficulty, design, originality, wear-ability, and attention to detail . Each design piece has a maximum cost of \$500.00.

Entry Categories:

- 1) Rings
- 2) Earrings
- 3) Bracelets
- 4) Pendants and Necklaces
- 5) Handmade Chains
- 6) Brooches, Enhancers and other miscellaneous jewelry accessories
- 7) Objects of Art (non jewelry items, liturgical art, hollowware, chalices, vases-containers)

Awards:

A Best of Show Piece will be selected by the judges and the winner will also receive an award. 1st and 2nd place winners in each category will receive an award. In addition there will be a Jeweler's Choice Award voted on by all the attendees.

Entry Deadline:

Entries must be received by February 15, 2010. Late entries will be disqualified.

Each design entrant agrees to hold harmless MJTS and Howard Academy against any and all actions that may arise out of theft, damage, or destruction of design pieces submitted for judging.
